MASTALONE is the Big Gun treatment for severe cases of mastitis or as a second line treatment where others have failed.

APPROVED FOR USE IN LACTATING COWS

Active Ingredients

Each syringe contains:

200mg Oxytetracycline Hydrochloride

100mg Oleandomycin

100mg Neomycin

5mg Prednisolone

PRODUCT FEATURES

- Contains a unique combination of 3 antibiotics
- Contains an anti-inflammatory to reduce udder inflammation and hasten recovery of milk quality.
- It has a 24 hour treatment interval meaning a course gives the antibiotic a long contact time with the bacteria. It also means you can complete the day's treatment at morning milking.

ADMINISTRATION

After milking, clean and disinfect the teat using teat wipes. Insert the syringe nozzle into the teat orifice and apply gentle and continuous pressure until the suspension is expressed into the teat canal. The treated quarter(s) may be milked out at the next normal milking time but the milk should be discarded.

Dose: Apply one syringe every 24 hours for 3 treatments per infected quarter.

PACK SIZE

Each box contains 20 syringes

WITHHOLDING PERIODS

MILK 96 hours / 8 milkings

MEAT 30 days

STORAGE

Store between 5°C and 25°C.
