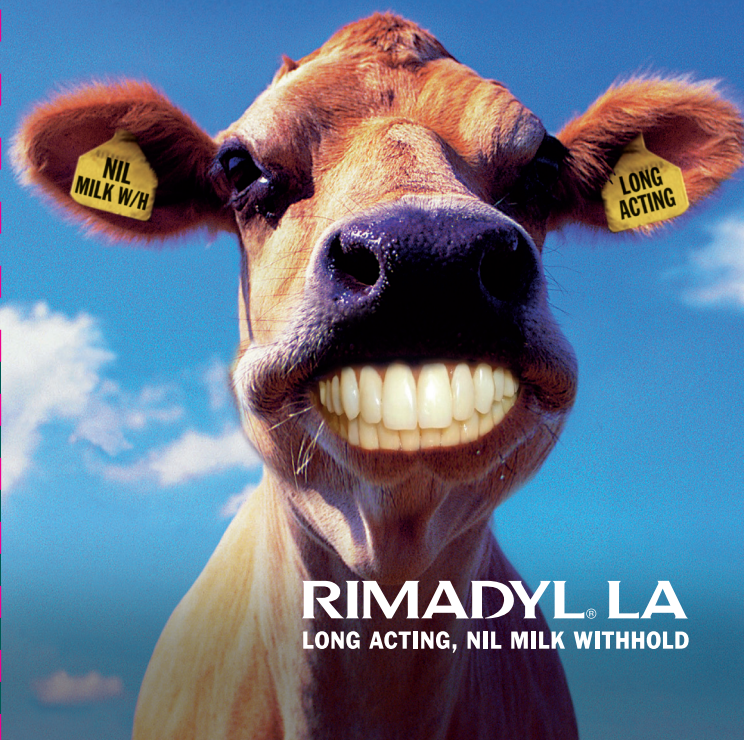

Rimadyl LA — Long acting Nil milk withhold.

Inflammation, fever and pain occur in many common conditions including:

- Difficult calvings
- Downer cows
- Lameness
- Mastitis
- Metritis/RFM (Retained Foetal Membranes)
- Pneumonia
- Surgical interventions, dehorning/ disbudding, castration, tailing
